She/he assists the implementation of PRP program proposing strategy to further increase access by integrating and expanding the Service Users Referral System, Repairmen Network and quality of PR services provided in the assisted centers.

Duties and Responsibilities

- (national and international CRPD) and developing and implementing a national Disability Inclusion Strategy/policy in the country.

About you

To be successful as the Disability Inclusion Advisor in the Physical Rehabilitation Program, you should possess the following qualifications, experiences and characteristics:

- Minimum 3-5 years' professional experience in the field of social inclusion or disability.

- Proven ability to coach and advise organizations (capacity building).
- Experience in the areas of technical and vocational education and training (i.e. education, livelihood, employment/economic empowerment) an asset. Knowledge of the legal framework and National action. Previous ICRC experience is also a strong asset.
